After serious consideration, Bank of America has decided to consolidate and reduce staff in the Consumer Banking-Legacy Asset Servicing unit at 2000 Clayton Road, Concord, CA 94520 and 1655 Grant Street, Concord, CA 94520. This layoff is expected to be permanent.

Notification began on October 23, 2013 and the effective date of separation is expected to occur on December 22, 2013. As a result of this decision, approximately 85 associates will be separated. Eligible associates are offered career transition resources as well as severance pay and benefits. No bumping rights exist. Associates at this site are not represented by a Union. 89
