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Dear WARN Act Coordinator:

This letter is to notify you that Stonyfield Farm, Inc. has adopted a plan to relocate the production of Brown Cow yogurt likely resulting in a plant closing (as that term is defined in the federal and California Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification ("WARN") Acts) that will likely result in the permanent termination of the employment of approximately **58** employees at Stonyfield Farm, Inc.'s, Brown Cow Farm manufacturing facility and corporate offices located at 3810 Delta Fair Blvd., Antioch, California 94509. While no exact date has been established for the closure and employment terminations, they are anticipated to begin on or about **April 1, 2014** and continue through **July 31, 2014**. With regard to the approximately 45 employees represented by Teamsters Local Union No. 853, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, we have already opened a dialogue with the Union about these relocation plans and we will meet all of our contractual and legal obligations to the Teamsters.

This notice is being provided to your office in compliance with the federal WARN Act, pursuant to 20 C.F.R. § 639.7(±), as well as California's WARN Act, Sections 1401-1408 of California's Labor Law.

The names of the affected employees and their job titles can be found in an addendum to this letter. Please see the attached addendum.


